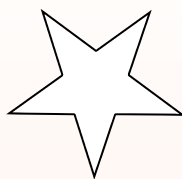

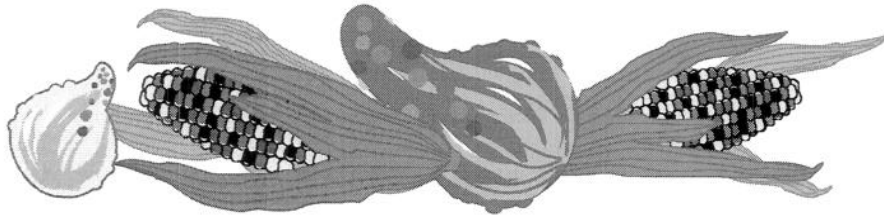
Friendship Night and our annual Harvest Auction. We will also be honoring Grand Representatives.

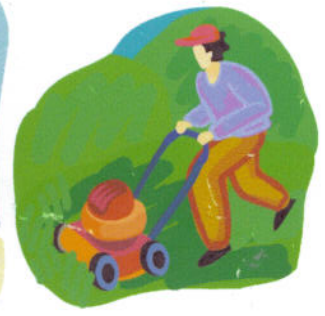
Presiding Worthy Matrons are welcomed and encouraged to attend. The annual election of officers will be held.
