Eastern Star in the state of Idaho By Pat McDonald, Grand Representative of Idaho in California

I am excited to tell California OES about my Grand Jurisdiction of Idaho. We have many things similar, and lots of fun things that are different.

First off, Idaho itself is nowhere near as large in square miles as California – 83,642 square miles versus 163,696 for California. But truth be told, travel times from furthest point to furthest point is similar – 8 hours for Idaho (Pocatello to Sandpoint) and 11 hours for California (San Diego to Weed.) Plus, in Idaho, there are two time zones so that could add an hour to your trip!

Idaho has 26 chapters and approximately 1,400 members. Grand Chapter is held typically from about June 10->14th every year. And, their chapter installations of new officers usually take place in April – **BEFORE** Grand Chapter!

California Grand Secretary Tammy Kinzey found 98 California OES members that currently live in Idaho. And a survey of Idaho chapters finds about 20 Idaho Star members living in California. One of the members of Hermosa Chapter in Caldwell actually lives right around the corner from me in Paradise Park – small world!!

I love this – Idaho Code and Digest compares to California's Constitution and Laws.....but Idaho's is about 102 pages long (including Instructions) where California's is more like 400 pages! Plus in California, there is a 125-page Instruction Book of another set of things to absorb.

During the closing of a chapter meeting in California, while we close the Bible, we sing the Evening Song ("if I have wounded any soul today....") Members moving to other jurisdictions usually really miss this, as that is not done in other places. But, Idaho incoming Worthy Matrons and Patron select their own Odes; my Sister Joan selected the Evening Song as her chapter closing ode to be sung. California finds us using the Odes selected by the Worthy Grand Matron and Patron.

So lots of differences but even more similarities! I will be telling you more about myself and about the different chapters next.






