



OEStools.org and getting the SWISH logo








By clicking on the "Idaho" link, here is what comes up:

This Style Guide has all sorts of interesting information – guidelines on FONT, on COLOR and so forth. It talks




about BRANDING and even suggestions as to where and how to place the logo on your promotional item.
