100	P	Each article submitted to the local newspaper highlighting a chapter activity (such as installation, community project or involvement, etc. (attach to this form)
100	Q	Volunteer at or sponsors a Veterans activity (such as make gift bags for a special holiday.) Make & donate items to a Veteran's facility. (such as an afghan or lap blanket)

- 100 R** Three or more members of a chapter together attend a meeting at a different chapter that is **NOT** an official visit, friendship night, Honor night, or Installation.
- 250 S** Each meeting where **ALL** installed officers are present
- 250 T** If **ALL** installed officers are present for the School of Instruction & Official Visit
- 250 U** If 3 or more Chapter Members work/volunteer with a Non-Profit Organization
- 500 V** If you hold a fun chapter activity with at least 4 Chapter Members present
- 500 X** If you raise money in your community for the WGM & WGP's Special Project as a chapter with at least 4 members present (must wear OES emblems - such as T-shirts, aprons, jackets, shirts, sweatshirts, hats, etc. so people know who we are)
- 500 Y** Participates in a Community Activity or Service Project as a chapter with at least 4 members present (must wear OES emblems - such as T-shirts, aprons, jackets, shirts, sweatshirts, hats, etc. so people know who we are. Examples include, but are not limited to: a table at a craft fair, sponsor a Christmas family, float in a parade)
- 500 Z** Have at least 4 Chapter Members Registered & Paid to attend Grand Chapter 2020

Your chapter needs to earn **2,000** points to receive this award. All activities must occur between the dates of 06/12/2019 to 05/31/2020.

Examples of Service Projects, Community Projects and/or Non-Profits include: Soup Kitchen, Food Bank, Highway Cleanup, Salvation Army Bell Ringers, Community Thanksgiving Day Dinner, Canine Companions for Independence, Habitat for Humanity, HIKE Run, Make-A-Wish Idaho events, Shamrock Shuffle, Shrine Circus, helping a shut-in, holding a food drive, visiting residents in a local Independent/Assistant Living Facility.
